Background of the “new policy”

- Deficit of Qualified Doctors in Hospitals
 - Almost all Specialists leave the Hospital after the End of Specialization
- Time and Money needed for Regular MM Education and Training in Courses
- But:
 - No Control for the Teachers Quality (Knowledge, Skills and Attitude)
 - No Control for the Suitability of the Educational Site
 - Result: Decrease of Quality in Techniques
 - Result: Decrease of Safety for the Patients

- Thanks to Wolfgang von Heymann, we have carried out a very extensive curriculum according to FIMM criteria in Turkey. Under the leadership of Dr. von Heymann and myself, we have trained more than 150 colleagues until now. Of these, 84 colleagues are fully certified and have received a diploma here. In addition to this training regulations, we have also trained instructors. Under my guidance we have over seven course instructors.

- In Turkey, in addition to our courses, all of which we have provided in full accordance to the FIMM guidelines and which still continue, other courses take place from other teachers of other FIMM National Member Societies, that are not based in Turkey. Since we have enough course instructors, we as the national FIMM member society do not really need a course leader from abroad. If we need further training, we always have the opportunity to receive further education and training in cooperation with Wolfgang von Heymann.

- We do not want accept this. I wanted to discuss this situation personally in the General Assembly. However, because of my health I can not do that unfortunately.
- Without the approval of our association and our instructors in our country, we do not consider this to be a kind of friendly cooperation. We ask you to take precautions to avoid such courses. I ask to discuss this important topic. I ask all of you to discuss this issue and ask those course instructors of other FIMM Member Societies, as far as they are not directly in charge of us, to stop these courses.
