

Organizational chart of KSCMM Steering Committee









Textbook 2002Chuna Manual Medicine included in curriculum of all 11 Colleges of Korean Medicine. Chuna educational textbooks were first published in 1995. The current main textbook in its current form was first published in 2011 (1st ed.), and was recently updated in September 2017 (2.5th ed.).
