

TRIGGER POINTS—Head and Neck


The most common pain syndrome: Trapezius

#### **Innervation**


- Motor:
  - spinal accessory nerve (CN XI)
- Sensory (pain, proprioception):
  - ventral rami of C3 and C4

muscle of the upper limb


 trapezius is not innervated by dorsal rami (despite it being superficial on the back)






### **Trapezius Needling**
